

Be It Remembered that the Greene County Council met in Special Session on Monday, June 24, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. in the Commissioners’ Room on the third floor of the Courthouse.

The meeting was called to order by Jerry Frye.

The Pledge of Allegiance opened the meeting.

Those present were: Jerry R. Frye, Gregg Roudebush, Joe Huntington, Jonas Uland, Brent Murray, Ronald Lehman, and County Attorney Marvin Abshire.

Re: Proposed Correctional or Rehabilitation Facilities Income Tax – Second Reading

At 4:01 p.m., County Attorney Marvin Abshire read the Second Reading of the proposed Correctional or Rehabilitation Facilities Income Tax, Ordinance #2019-04, which is a .02% income tax used primarily to make the Jail Renovation Bond Payments. The reading concluded at 4:03 p.m.

Re: Call for Discussion

There was clarification given by County Marvin Abshire that approval of the proposed Correctional or Rehabilitation Facilities Income Tax, Ordinance #2019-04, did not by its passage constitute any type of salary increase. Discussion was then closed.

Re: Call for Vote

Jonas Uland made a motion to approve the Correctional or Rehabilitation Facilities Income Tax, Ordinance #2019-04, as presented. Gregg Roudebush seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-2. Brent Murray and Ron Lehman voted against. It should be noted that a simple majority is all that is needed for approval of this ordinance at its second reading. Terms of this ordinance are incorporated by reference.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Ron Lehman made a motion to adjourn. Jonas Uland seconded the motion. Motion passed 6-0. The special meeting concluded at 4:05 p.m.
