## Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Greene County Building Corporation January 28, 2015 at 8:30

There was a discussion regarding the posting of minutes of the Board on the county website. A motion was made by Steve Mitchell and seconded by Tom Pafford to post minutes beginning in 2015. The motion was approved unanimously.

The Corporation attorney updated the Board members regarding the status of the outstanding bonds and leases held by the Building Corporation.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
