there was not a report from the Linton site. Switz City customer and revenue counts were orally

reported as follows: For the month of October, the user visits averaged 55 per day and the revenue

averaged \$120.00 per day.

The next item of business was the Tire Amnesty completion report. Ed Michael reported that

Charles M. Gallion, d/b/a Gallion's Affordable Hauling and Repair has agreed to process all tires

received by the District at the Recycling Center in a manner compliant with recycling requirements of

IDEM and will begin in the next couple of weeks. Marvin Abshire has prepared an Agreement for

Professional Services and an Equipment Lease for signature.

The next item of business the 2021 County Holiday Schedule adopted by the Greene County

Commissioners. A motion was made by Jeff Sparks and seconded by Nathan Abrams to adopt the

holiday schedule for the District. The motion was passed unanimously. A copy of the 2021 Holidays
