

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting  
of the  
Greene County Emergency Medical Services Board  
October 19, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Greene County Emergency Medical Services Board was held in the Commissioners' Room of the Greene County Courthouse on October 19, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. Present in person were Ed Michael, Mike Hasler, and Joe Huntington. Present by phone was Brad Norton. Absent was Troy Gaither. Also present in person were the Board's attorney Marvin Abshire and Director Doug Hall.

The meeting was called to order by President Ed Michael.

The first item of business was review and approval of the minutes of the September 21, 2021 regular meeting. A motion was made by Mike Hasler and seconded by Joe Huntington to waive the reading and approve the minutes as presented. A roll call vote was conducted, and the motion passed 4-0.

Director Doug Hall updated the Board as follows:

1. Revenue for September was \$101,029.06, lower than normal, but a nationwide software hack led to off-line status for nine days. As a result, next month's revenue should be higher than normal.
2. Run volume for September was 264 billable transports, down from 292 in August.
3. The ambulance mileage report was circulated.
4. No major repairs were noted, only routine maintenance.

A Field Supervisor job description was circulated to replace the existing Paramedic Field Supervisor job description. The new job description will allow the Field Supervisor to be an EMT or a Paramedic and the salary for this position is two-tiered, depending on whether it is filled with an EMT or Paramedic. A motion was made by Mike Hasler and seconded by Joe Huntington to recommend the Field Supervisor job description, as presented, to the County Council for approval. A roll call vote was conducted, and the motion passed 4-0.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Joe Huntington and seconded by Mike Hasler to adjourn. A roll call vote was conducted, and the motion passed 4-0.
