

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting  
of the  
Greene County Emergency Medical Service Board  
April 19, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Greene County Emergency Medical Service Board was held in the Commissioners' Room of the Greene County Courthouse on April 19, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. Present in person were Ed Michael, Mike Hasler, Ron Lehman, and Brad Norton. Present by phone was Troy Gaither. Also present in person was Director Doug Hall.

The meeting was called to order by President Ed Michael.

The first item of business was review and approval of the minutes from the March 15, 2022 regular meeting. A motion was made by Brad Norton and seconded by Ron Lehman to waive the reading and approve the minutes as presented. The motion passed 4-0.

Director Doug Hall updated the Board as follows:

1. Medicaid grant application for two bariatric ambulances will be submitted today.
2. Annual Medicaid cost report is progressing.
3. Renewal of state provider certification is due in June.
4. No major repairs were reported.
5. Application for Health Issues and Challenges Grant has been submitted.
6. Revenue for March, 2022 was \$152,769.94. Revenue is up \$17,503.36 compared to the same period as last year.
7. Run volume for March was 345 calls with 259 in transports.

Doug Hall informed the board that the Greene County Ambulance Service has a surplus cot which is no longer useful. Doug Hall would like to donate the cot to Wagler Education & Training Center in Lyons. The Board of Commissioners approved donation of the cot pending approval by the Emergency Medical Service Board. A motion was made by Mike Hasler and seconded by Ron Lehman to donate the cot to Wagler Education & Training Center. The motion passed 4-0.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Ron Lehman and seconded by Mike Hasler to adjourn. The motion passed 4-0.
